



Minhang Crosspoint Academy is a rigorous US High School College Preparatory “3+1” Diploma program cooperating with **California Crosspoint Academy (CCA)**. Students spend their ninth, tenth, and eleventh grades studying in English on our Shanghai campus, then transition in their senior year to the United States at our “Sister” school, California Crosspoint Academy in Hayward, California. Students completing their senior year at CCA receive an accredited College Preparatory Diploma that meets A-G requirements. In consultation with CCA, Minhang Crosspoint has created a China alternative, following the same rigorous academic standards, and students graduate from Minhang Crosspoint Academy at Shanghai Wenqi Middle School with a COGNIA-accredited College Preparatory Diploma. Minhang Crosspoint develops future global leaders under **Ms. Hudlin Wagner, former Vice President of Carleton College**. We believe in the foundational importance of scholarship, and we prepare our students to make a positive difference through engagement in a full array of school activities, community service, and learning opportunities in the broader world.

CURRICULUM

Minhang Crosspoint Academy provides a rigorous and varied high school education for all students. Both AP and Honors courses challenge students academically. In addition, student-led clubs and electives allow students to learn in varied realms. Our courses are modeled after California Crosspoint Academy’s curriculum and course syllabuses. This creates a seamless educational learning experience for our students when they transfer to CCA for their senior year. California Crosspoint Academy academic courses comply with the academic standards for college preparatory study in the USA, using the California “a-g” or College Board Advanced Placement Standards as guides.

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

All of our students come from China and various cities, towns, and villages. Our current enrollment is 408 students: 226 boys, 180 girls. There are 64 students in the senior class, 82 students in 9th grade. The primary languages spoken at home are Mandarin and Cantonese.
